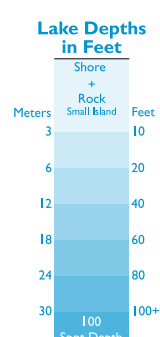
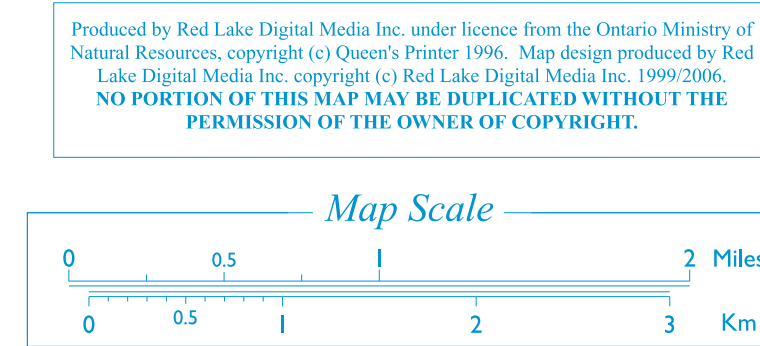
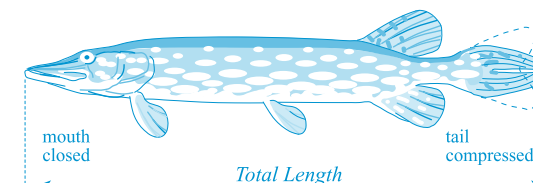
Walleye (4) full licence, (2) conservation
 No Walleye between 46-58 cm (18.3-22.8 in)
 Only (1) may exceed 58 cm (22.8 in)
Northern (4) full licence, (2) conservation
 No Northern between 70-90 cm (27.5-35.4 in)
 Only (1) may exceed 90 cm (35.4 in)
Lake Trout daily possession of (1)
 Total possession (2) full licence, (1) conservation
 Only one may exceed 65 cm (25.6 in)
 In September only one may exceed 56 cm (22 in)
Smallmouth Bass (from opener until June 30th)
 (2) full licence, (1) conservation
 Must be less than 35 cm (13.75 in)
Smallmouth Bass (after June 30th)
 (4) full licence, (2) conservation licence
 No size restrictions
Lake Trout (2) full licence, (1) conservation
 In September only one may exceed 56 cm (22 in)
Muskie minimum size 122 cm (48 in)
 (1) full licence, (0) conservation licence
Whitefish (25) full licence, (12) conservation

Portage Lakes including Walleye, Trout, Brown Trout, Clearwater, Buzzard, Crabclaw and Edison Lakes

Walleye (4) full licence, (2) conservation
 Only (1) may exceed 46 cm (18.1 in)
Northern (4) full licence, (2) conservation
 No Northern between 70-90 cm (27.5-35.4 in)
 Only (1) may exceed 90 cm (35.4 in)
Smallmouth Bass (from opener until June 30th)
 (2) full licence, (1) conservation
 Must be less than 35 cm (13.75 in)
Smallmouth Bass (after June 30th)
 (4) full licence, (2) conservation licence
 No size restrictions
Lake Trout (2) full licence, (1) conservation
 In September only one may exceed 56 cm (22 in)
