



Stanley's guests can be fishing the only trout holes on Eagle Lake with Lake Trout within minutes of leaving the dock. Also Stanley's Resort offers 5 portage lakes with Lake Trout as well. If you have never fished for trout before, it's well worth spending even a half of a day trying for these worthy opponents.

Smallmouth have long been know for their fantastic fight and airborne antics. Eagle Lake as well as several portage lakes are proving grounds for those who are looking to battle the bronze backs. Traditionally, springtime finds the Smallies most active, when the are making their beds for spawning. Regulations make you put the large spawners back at this time, but it sure makes for some great pictures and a great day. July brings the end of the size restriction, and a change of baits, leaning more towards deep water cranks, or even live bait.

STANLEY'S RESORT

Northwestern Ontario's Eagle Lake is approximately 90 miles in length and is one of the most scenic lakes in all of Ontario. Located on the Canadian Shield and clothed by boreal forest, it features six varieties of sportfish.

At its northwest corner, the wide open lake gives way to a narrow, 18 mile long sheltered and secluded area known as the West Arm. It consists of granite bluffs, islands, reefs, sand beaches, weedy bays, and deep drop-offs. The background picture shows how wide the West Arm is. With it being about one mile wide at its greatest point, we are always in a protected area. Our waters are home to great tasting walleye, hard fighting pike and bass, trophy muskie, deep lake trout, and a new species to some....whitefish.

Aside from the unlimited opportunities on Eagle Lake, Stanley's guests also have the opportunity to portage into any of 6 different lakes. By driving your boat up to a short portage, and then walking across carrying only your fishing gear..... another boat and motor, completely equipped with gas awaits you on the other side. This is all included in your package....No extra charges!

Considered one of the best tasting fish by many of our guests once we have served whitefish at our fish fry, you can catch them minutes away from your cottage. These deep schooling fish are great fighters and are easy to fish for...we'll show you how. Mainly sought after in late July to September, you can angle for whitefish and lake trout at the same time. If you don't have a heavy pole that is suitable for the 4 to 6 oz. of weight we use to get down to the right depth, don't worry, we have several you can borrow.



At one time Eagle Lake held the world record for muskie at 62 lbs. Trophy muskie swim the deep clear waters of the West Arm, and usually only expose themselves the the well prepared. If you fit the description, we'll show you where to start. Eagle lake has a 54 inch minimum size limit for muskie, but all muskies are CPR (catch - photo - release). Every season we see several muskies in the 50+ inch catogorey, and many more in the 40-49 inch range. We suggest taking John as a guide to at least get you started with our local tactics and techniques.

car to the landing and in 45 minutes you are catching 20 - 50 northerns per person. Sizes range from "hammer handles" to "lunkers". Keep a couple for shorelunch, and let the rest go. Great for sportsmen and kids. \$255 US for 2, \$15 for each extra adult. (max 6 adults)

Take a fly-in trip to one of our local lakes starting at \$250 US per adult (min 2 adults). Stanley's also works with our local air charter company and has fly-out service available right from our dock to over 20+ remote fly-in only lakes. These day trips costs vary by the size of group and the distance flown to the lake.

You can book these day trips once you arrive at Stanley's by talking with Rob and going over the different lake options. Due to the high aircraft costs, you can expect the fly-outs to start in the \$275+ per person range, and increase based on distance. The whole experience may outweight the cost factor, and it might be something you want to budget for.



How to get here.....

Stanley's Resort is located in Northwestern Ontario, Canada. We are eight miles west of the town of Vermilion Bay. Guests can drive paved roads right to your cottage door. We have only one mile of gravel between the resort and the Trans-Canada highway, and once you are at the resort, the driveway is paved. Most travellers from the midwest will cross the border into Ontario at International Falls MN. From there you are only about 3 hours from Stanleys.

Vaccination Status

Currently we are expecting for the 2022 season that vistors crossing into Canada must be fully vaccinated if they are eligible. There also may be a requirement for pre-arrival testing before crossing the border. Visitors well use the ArriveCan app to enter their information prior to arrival at the border.

Fishing Licences

Stanley's Resort is proud to promote conservation by including a conservation licence in every fishing package. The limits for a conservation licence are 2 walleye, 2 northern, 2 smallmouth, 6 whitefish and 1 lake trout. If you so desire you may purchase a full limit licence for approximately \$65 US. The limits are then 4 walleye, 4 northern, 4 smallmouth, 2 lake trout, 12 whitefish and 1 muskie. *Eagle Lake and surrounding portage lakes have slot sizes, daily possession as well as length limits*. These must be obeyed at all times. Your limit is talleyed daily by our staff and includes any fish that are in the resort freezers.

Deposits / Cancellation

Stanley's Resort requires a \$200 US per adult deposit to secure your reservation. Deposits must be received within 10 days of making a reservation. Deposits are refundable within 90 days of the trip date, less a 20% administrative fee. If cancellation is made less than 90 days, the entire deposit will then be forfeited.

Check-in / Check-out

Stanley's Resort adheres to the highest standards possible. We want to make sure that your equipment and cottage is ready for you upon your arrival. Thus check-ins before 2:00 PM on Saturdays are not possible. Check-out time is 9:00 AM the following Saturday, and guests should settle their accounts by 7:00 PM the night before (Friday).

Final Payment / Taxes

Stanley's Resort will accept cash, travellers checks, personal checks and Visa/ MC for deposits and final payments. Being a small business, Stanley's would prefer cash, travellers check or personal check for payment. *Please note, that your credit card company may charge you up to 3% surcharge for an out of country transaction. All* of Stanley's packages are subject to 13% HST (taxes).

Boat / Motor Damage Insurance

Stanley's now includes standard boat insurance with all packages using our boats. Small claims are covered with no deductable (props / skegs), and major damage claims require a \$500 deductable (per occurance). Zero deductable insurance can be purchased for your stay \$125 US per boat / week.

Crossing Into Canada

U.S. visitors need to have a passport to cross back into the US at any land crossing or airport. Your passport will work fine as identification to enter into Canada. If you are bringing children other than your own, you must have proper authorization in the form of a notarized letter and identification for the child. Visitors with a prior criminal conviction may be denied entry into Canada, please check into your admissibility prior to arrival at the border.

Pets

By request of our guests, Stanley's Resort has a no pet policy. Sorry, no exceptions. Service animals are always allowed.
